CONTINUING EDUCATION (CE) POLICY – HIGHLIGHTS

(An unofficial summary/for details refer to the Continuing Education Policy, Appendix IV, State Court Administrator Guidelines for the Nevada Certified Court Interpreter Program)

- 40 CE credits in 3 years
- 3 CE credits required in ethics
- No less than 10 CE credits per year, no more than 20 CE per year
- No more than 7 CE credits in non-interpreter/non-legal areas
- Minimum of 10 CE credits must be language specific
- Limit 7 CE credit per day
- Up to 5 CE credits per teaching activity (no more than 10 CE credits per year)
- Alternative study valid for no more than 13 CE credits
- Documentation provided to AOC by 12/31 of each year
