

CHILD SUPPORT ADDENDUM

THE ADVERSE PARTY IS ORDERED to pay child support as specified below for the minor child(ren): _____.

F. Health Insurance. Medical support for the child(ren) shall be provided through Medicaid
 Private/employer insurance. Any monthly premium shall be paid by: Adverse Party

G. Child Care Expenses. Any child care expenses shall be paid by: Adverse Party Applicant
 both parties equally.

H. Arrears. Applicant reserves the right to pursue child support arrears. Arrears have not been addressed in this Order.
