1 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that a copy of this order and the verified application for
2 protection order against domestic violence shall be transmitted directly to the applicable sheriff's
3 office or constable, who will promptly attempt to serve the transmitted documents upon the
4 Adverse Party, and upon service, file a return of service form with the court.

5 **If you want to dispute this order or have it changed, you can request a hearing by**
6 **filing a written request with this court.** Court staff will give you information about how to file
7 your request. The court will set a hearing on your request as quickly as possible.

8 **VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER IS A CRIME**

9 **You, the Adverse Party, are notified that you can be arrested for violating this order.**
10 You can be arrested even if the person who obtained this Order invites or allows you to contact
11 him or her. You have the sole responsibility to avoid or refrain from violating the terms of this
12 Order. A violation includes but is not limited to contact in the form of verbal, electronic, and
13 social media communications.

14 **You are further notified of the penalty for violation of an order. A person who**
15 **intentionally violates:** a temporary order is guilty of a gross misdemeanor (NRS 33.400) which
16 is punishable by up to one year imprisonment in the county jail and a fine of not more than
17 \$2,000.00. (NRS 193.140) Each act that constitutes a violation of the temporary order may be
18 prosecuted as a separate violation of this order.

19 Under federal law, this protection order is valid and enforceable in all 50 states, the District of
20 Columbia, U.S. Territories, and Indian Nations (18 USC § 2265.)

21 **Only the court can change this order.**

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ORDER TO LAW ENFORCEMENT

1 Any law enforcement officer, with or without a warrant, may arrest and take into custody
2 the Adverse Party, when the law enforcement officer has probable cause to believe that (a) an
3 Order has been issued pursuant to NRS 33.400 against the Adverse Party; (b) the Adverse Party
4 has been served with a copy of the Order; and (c) the Adverse Party is acting or has acted in
5 violation of the Order. This arrest may occur regardless of whether the violation occurred in the
6 officer’s presence.

7 Any law enforcement agency in this state may enforce a Court Order issued pursuant to
8 NRS 33.400 without regard to the county in which the Order is issued.
