3 **Rule 61. Harmless Error**

4 Unless justice requires otherwise, no error in admitting or excluding
5 evidence—or any other error by the court or a party—is ground for granting a new
6 trial, for setting aside a verdict, or for vacating, modifying, or otherwise disturbing a
7 judgment or order. At every stage of the proceeding, the court must disregard all
8 errors and defects that do not affect any party’s substantial rights.
