#### Have you included your:

- □ Completed Certification and/or Registration Request, signed and notarized?
- □ Documentation of continuing education (CE) credits as required in section 7 of the State Court Administrator Guidelines for the Nevada Certified Court Interpreter Program?
- □ Verification of 'in-court' and 'out-of-court' experience (a total of 120 hours of interpretation is required during the three-year renewal period)?
- □ Criminal history check information (2 fingerprint cards)?
- □ Check or money order for \$50?

### **Basic Requirements**

All the following requirements apply to all persons requesting Foreign Language Certification or Registration Renewal from the State of Nevada:

- □ Pay a renewal fee of \$50.00 to the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC), and
- □ Complete an application form in order to document the current name, address, and other information of the interpreter, and
- □ Undergo a criminal history records check; and
- Provide documentation of continuing education credits as required in section 7 of the State Court Administrator Guidelines for the Nevada Certified Court Interpreter Program; and
- □ Interpret a total of 120 hours in the three-year renewal period of 'incourt' proceedings and 'out-of-court' legal interviews or depositions and provide documentation of work hours. A minimum of 10 hours of actual court interpreter experience is required. It is recommended that 40 hours per year be obtained over the three-year period.

Please read **ALL of the enclosed materials** carefully before filling out and submitting the Certification Request.

### LAPSE OF NV COURT INTERPRETER CREDENTIAL

A Nevada certified/registered interpreter who does not meet the renewal requirements before the expiration of the interpreter's certificate, but who still wishes to pursue recertification, has 6 months from the expiration date to complete the requirements, and upon completion may request recertification without having to retest (written and oral). During this period, the certification will be considered to have expired, and the interpreter will not be **certified**. If the interpreter is unable to complete the requirements within 6 months, but can show progress, he/she may take up to 1 year from the expiration date. If an interpreter must take extra time, the new certification period will extend only from expiration date of the preceding certification period.

NRS § 50.054 reads in part:

- 2. Before undertaking his duties, the interpreter shall swear or affirm that he will:
  - (a) To the best of his ability, translate accurately to the witness, in the language of the witness, questions and statements addressed to the witness;
  - (b) Make a true interpretation of the statements of the witness in an understandable manner; and
  - (c) Repeat the statements of the witness in the English language to the best of his ability.
- 3. While in the proper performance of his duties, an interpreter has the same rights and privileges as the witness, including the right to examine all relevant material, but is not entitled to waive or exercise any of those rights or privileges on behalf of the witness.
- 4. As used in this section, "interpreter" means a person who is readily able to communicate with a person who speaks a language other than English and does not know the English language, translate the proceedings for him and accurately repeat and translate the statements of the person in a language other than English to the court, magistrate or other person presiding.
