## Legal Aid Center

## Immigration Services Include:

- VAWA Petitions: For survivors of domestic violence
- U-Visas: For victims of serious crimes who assist law enforcement
- T-Visas: For victims of human trafficking
- SIJS (Special Immigrant Juvenile Status): For unaccompanied minors or children in foster care

Legal Aid Center also provides support to families facing detention or deportation, working to protect family unity and individual rights.
